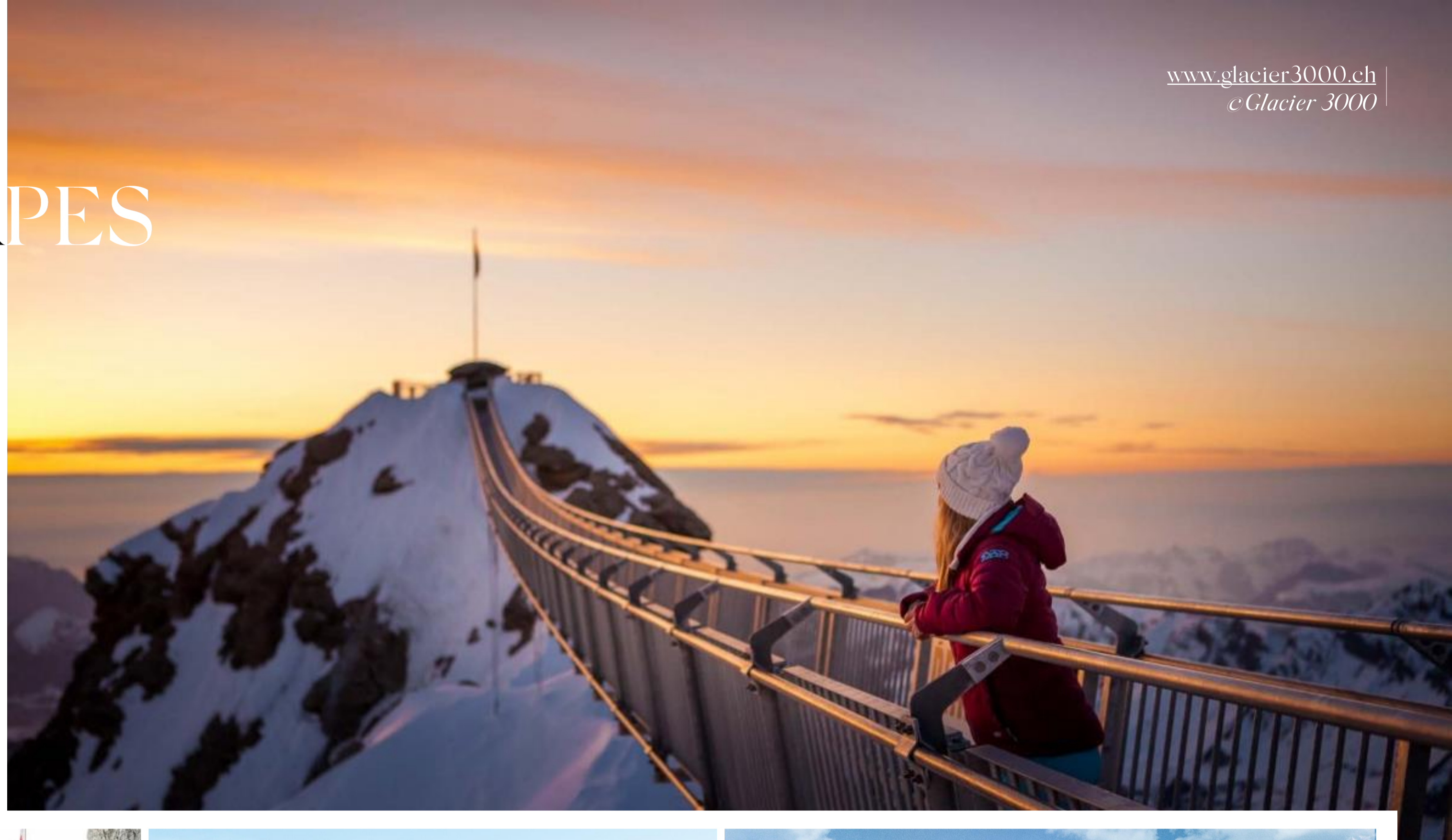
HOW TO GET THERE:

For those seeking a more adventurous experience, a trip to Glacier 3000 is a must. Another popular destination is Rochers de Naye, where visitors hike, paraglide, or simply take in the breathtaking scenery. A train ride away is also the medieval town of Gruyère, famous for its castle and cheese factory.

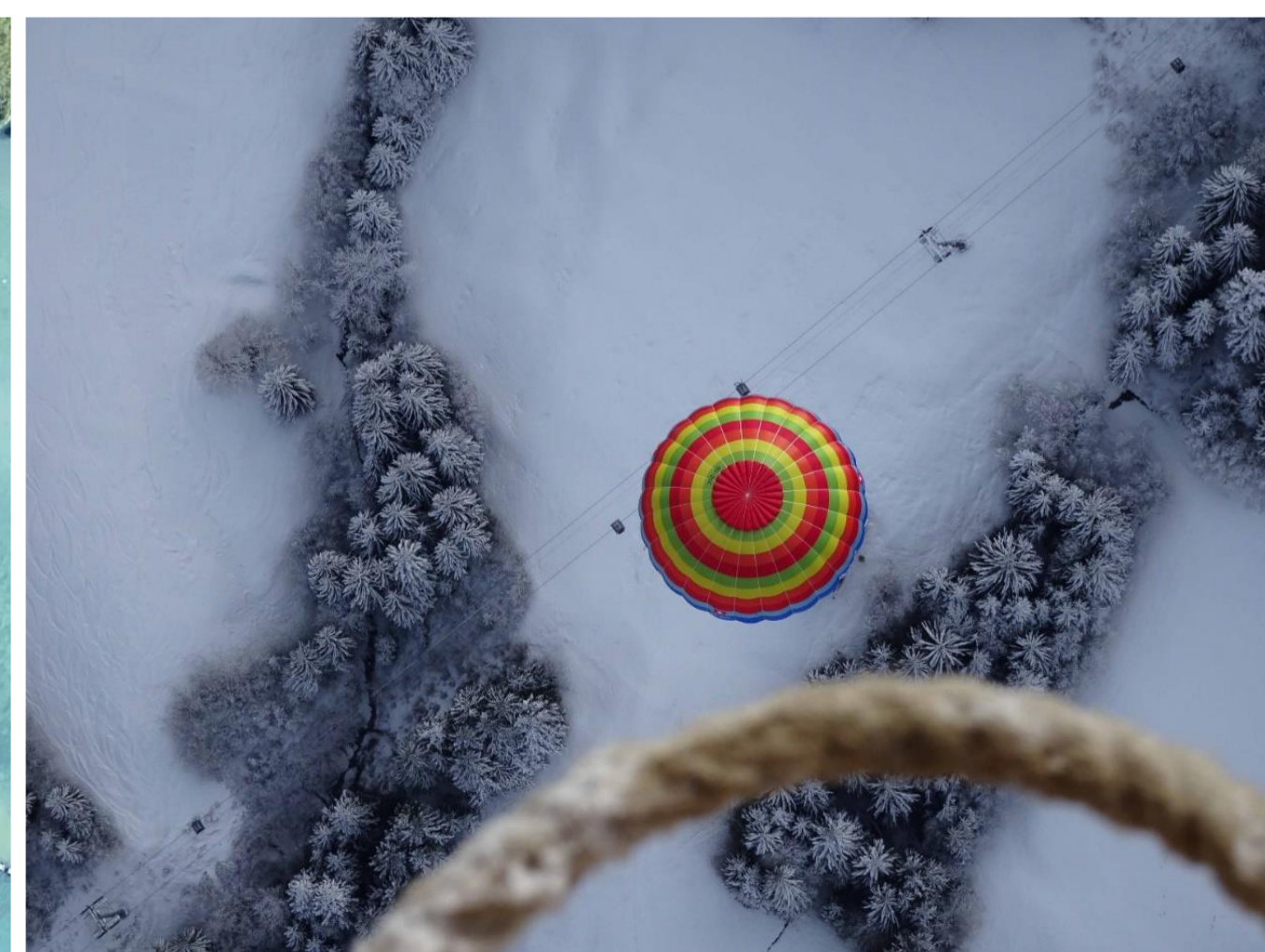
Air PATHS

During the last week in January every year, Château-d'Oex provides the setting for an international spectacle, which is the leading alpine ballooning event: the "Semaine Internationale de Ballons à Air Chaud" (International Hot Air Balloon Week) involves around 90 balloon pilots and is full of fascinating colours and shapes!

Villeneuve offers ideal weather conditions for paragliding. The views offered are totally unique for this region. Fly above Montreux, Chillon Castle, the Swiss Riviera Lake Geneva and you will experience an unforgettable feeling of freedom.

Trains & CRUISES

Montreux is a hub for many train excursions, including the new GoldenPass Express, which takes you on a spectacular journey from Montreux to Interlaken, with panoramic views of majestic mountain peaks, glittering lakes and charming Alpine villages. With our hotel just a 5-minute walk from the train station, you'll have easy access to these unforgettable train journeys!

The Belle Époque boats have been navigating Central Europe's largest inland lake for 140 years and offer fantastic cruises between France and Switzerland. The views from the boat extend from harbors and castles over vineyards to the Alps snow-covered summits.

Lavaux VINEYARDS

Covering 800 hectares, Lavaux is the largest contiguous vineyard region in Switzerland, and its daringly constructed hillside terraces have been protected by UNESCO since 2007. Right at the start, the medieval St. Saphorin with its narrow alleys and characteristic winegrowers' houses from the 16th to 19th centuries is worth a visit. On some days of the week the "Lavaux Express" is ready to comfortably transport tired hikers through the World Heritage Region, as is the "Lavaux- Panoramic" train, which takes hikers through the same region.

Skiing

Villars-sur-Ollon (CH) – Villars offers an international ambience, with guests of all ages. There are a few exclusive private schools located here.

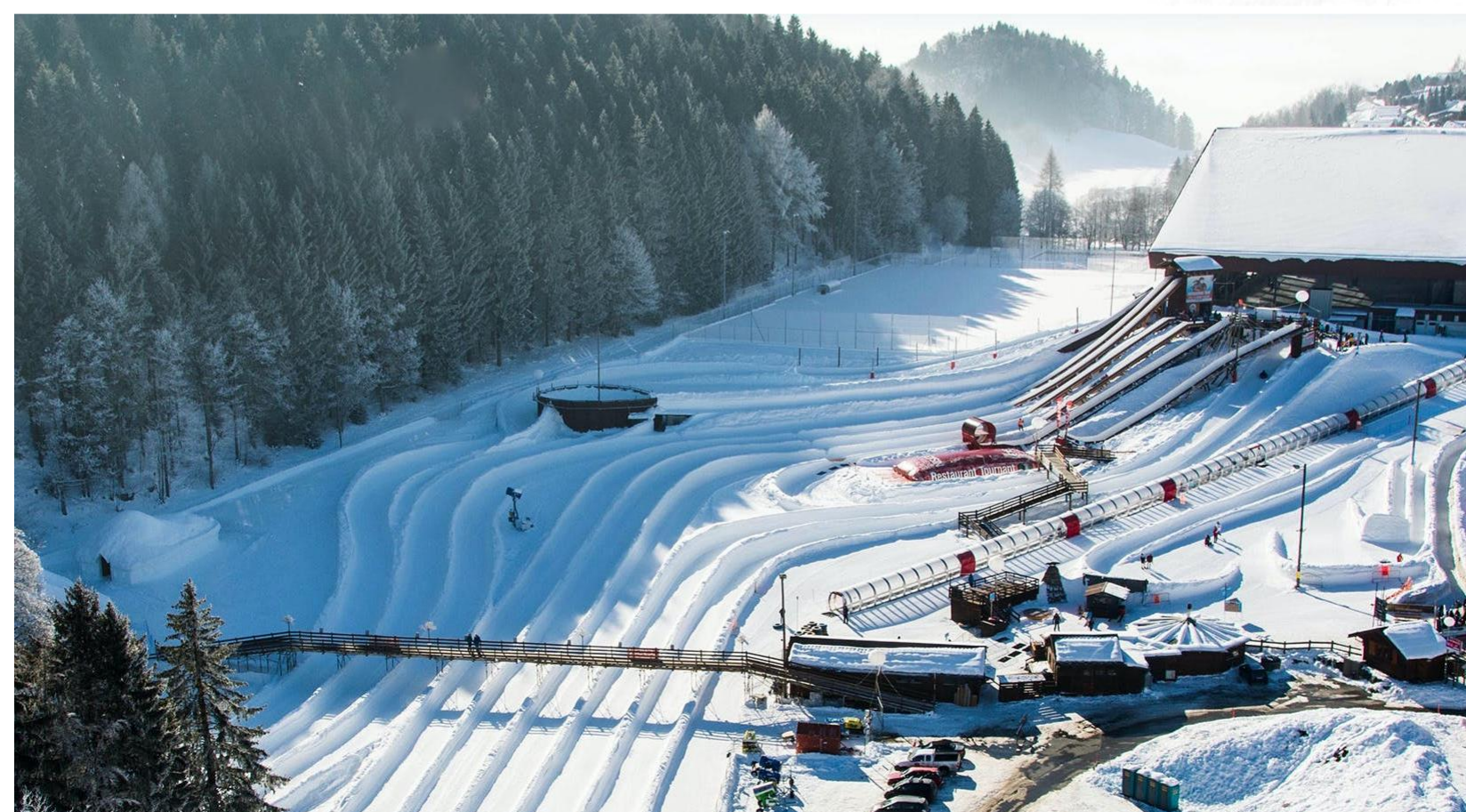
Les Portes du Soleil (CH & FR) – Situated at the gateway to canton Valais, it is an idyllic setting in the mountains with a wide range of sporting, recreational and cultural activities.

Leysin (CH) – Located on a terrace at an altitude of 1200 meters above Aigle in the lower Rhone Valley.

Moléson (CH) – This is the largest skiing area in the Fribourg region.

Rafting / Canyoning

Across the wild gorges of Vanel and Gérignoz you will find a 15 km rafting course, one of the most beautiful in Switzerland, to be encountered in rafts with 4 to 8 places. Visitors can also make use of the canyoning, canoe-kayaking or hydrospeed (white water sledging / riverboarding) facilities. Between mid-April and the end of August (between the end of June and the end of September for canyoning). Departure point opposite Glasson Matériaux.



Tobogganing

Ice tobogganing is a form of fun for anyone who likes to get their adrenalin flowing! What could be better than racing down the slopes, some of them up to 250 m long, with built-in steep curves. The boldest will test themselves on the track with the 360° curve, while there are special minislopes for children.

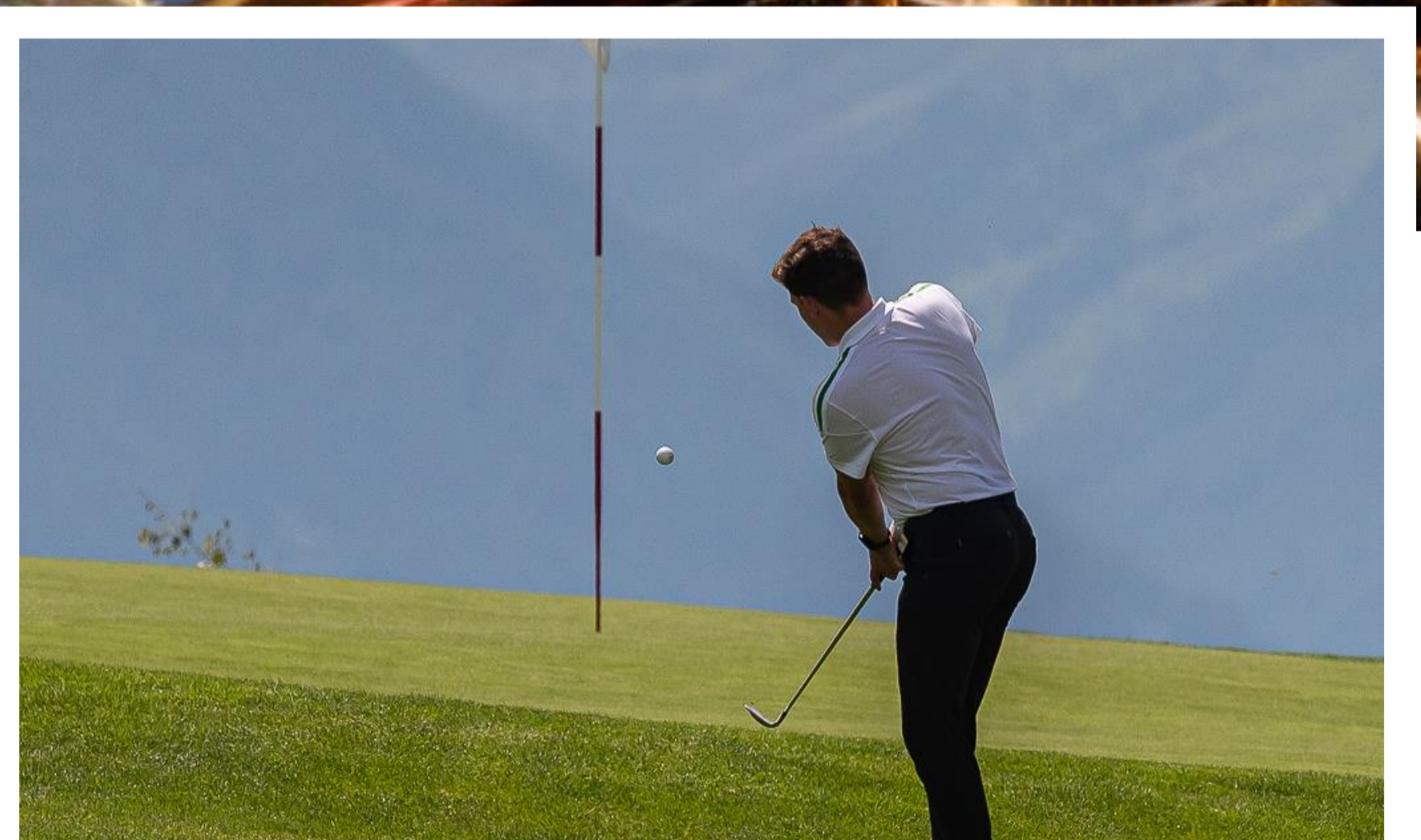
Golf Club AIGLE

Protected by the surrounding mountains and out of reach of the mists of Lake Geneva, the golf course lies at the centre of an unusually mild microclimate.

The museum is the largest information center on the subject of the Olympic Games in the world.

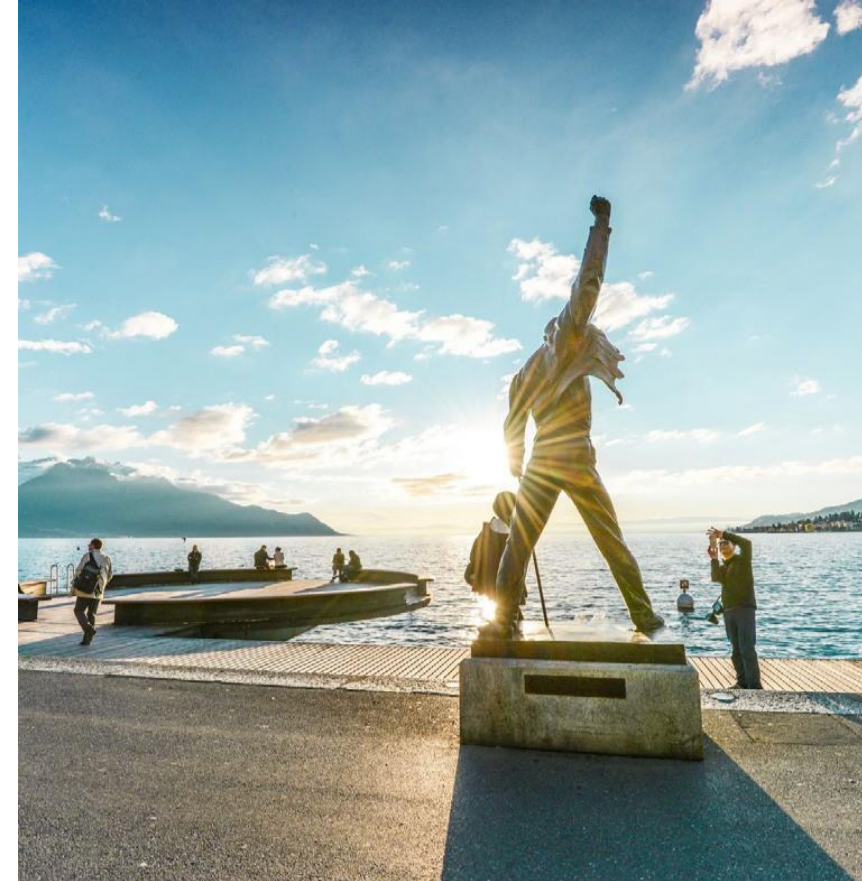

Queen Studio

An exhibition on the work of Queen in the 1970s has been staged in the world-famous Montreux Mountain Studios at Casino Barrière Montreux, where the band created a major portion of their most successful albums. The exhibits include numerous memorabilia, such as the handwritten original versions of the songs or instruments. The centerpiece of the exhibition is the original sound studio that was used by the band and where Freddie Mercury recorded his last songs.

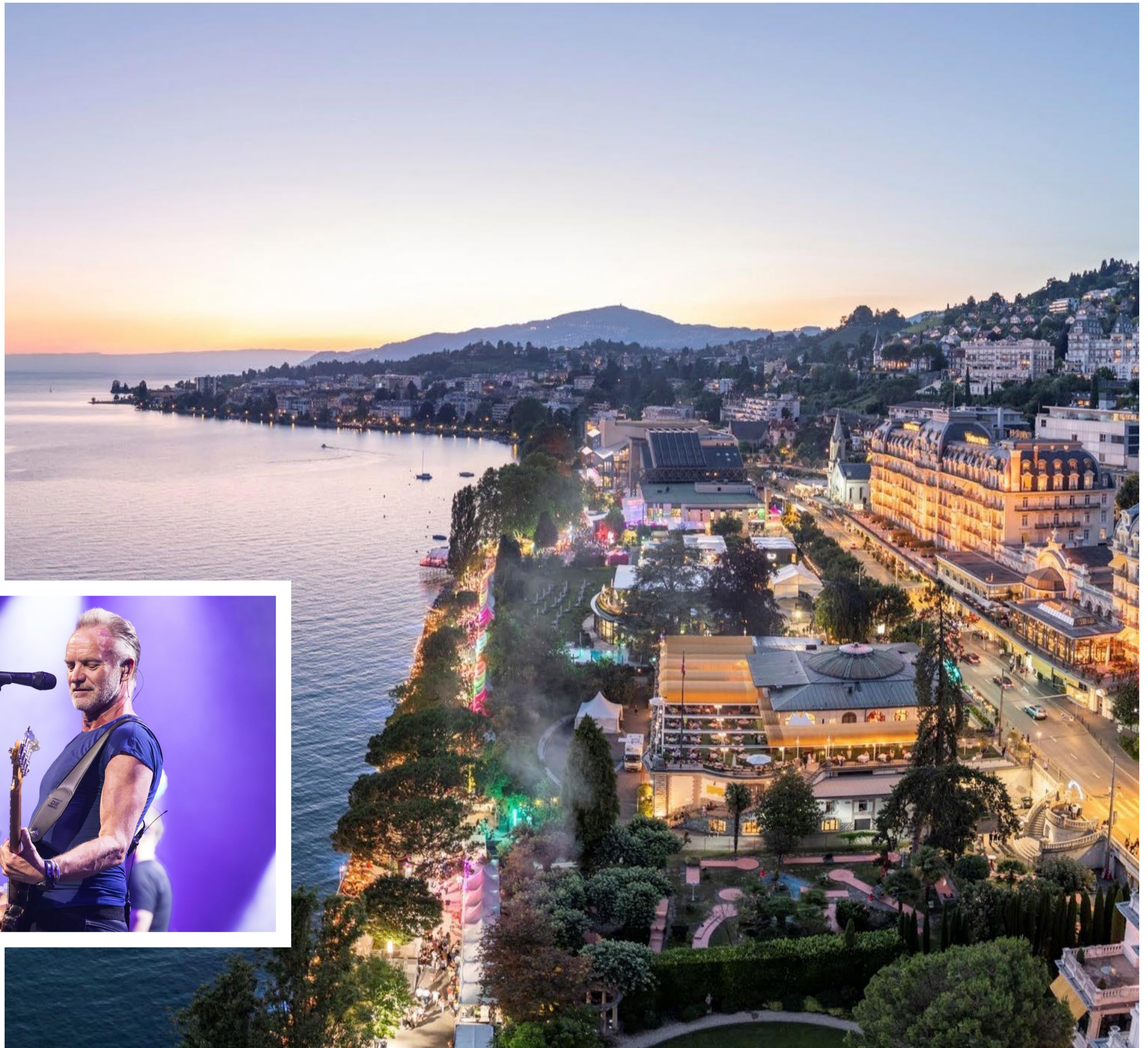

Montreux Jazz Festival

Over the past 50 years the Montreux Jazz Festival has become a singular rendez-vous in the world of music, taking place the first two weeks of July each year. Originally a pure jazz festival, it opened up in the 1970s and today presents artists of nearly every imaginable music style. Jazz remains an important part of the festival. Part of the festival's expansion was due to coproduction by Quincy Jones who brought many international artists in the early 1990s. The festival attracts an audience of more than 200'000 people.
